Autopsy: Fairport teens died on impact

All five Fairport High School graduates killed in last week's head-on collision with a tractor-trailer in Ontario County died on impact, according to autopsy results released today.

At the time of the crash, the teens — Hannah Congdon, Bailey Goodman, Meredith McClure, Sara Monnat and Katherine "Katie" Shirley, all of Perinton — were traveling to the Goodman family's vacation home on Keuka Lake in Yates County.

The autopsies, performed by the Monroe County Medical Examiner's Office, also confirmed that alcohol was not a factor in the accident, said Lt. Bill Gallagher of the Ontario County Sheriff's Office, which released the results this morning.

The Medical Examiner's Office is still waiting for further toxicology results, to determine whether drugs were a factor in the crash. Gallagher said those tests take more time and noted that it could be weeks until deputies learn the results.

Deputies are still investigating the accident, to determine what specifically caused the crash. Last week, Ontario County Sheriff Philip Povero said the SUV driver — Bailey Goodman — had successfully passed an eastbound van on Routes 5 and 20, then overcorrected and veered into the path of the westbound tractor-trailer.
