

## Charges Made in Teen Drinking Party

A Conesus couple is facing charges for allegedly hosting an underage drinking party.

Livingston County Sheriff's Deputies say Gerald and Charlene Presler held a party in their home where several minors drank alcohol. The party took place last Saturday.

The Presler's face seven counts of unlawfully dealing with a child. Livingston County District Attorney Tom Moran tells us the charges are related to the recent sports suspension of athletes at Livonia High School.

Four Livonia football players suspended from Friday's sectional playoff game were at the party the Preslers are accused of hosting.

Sherry Converse, a parent said, "In light of the fact that we just had this happen in city {Brighton} and it's been all over the news, I think it's hard to believe a family would repeat the same thing. It's just wrong. It's a terrible model for minors."

Livonia lost Friday's game in overtime.

The Presler's are expected to appear in the Town of Conesus court at a later date.
