Perinton Wegmans offers time off for grieving workers

In the wake of the car accident that killed five 2007 Fairport High School graduates, the Perinton Wegmans store is offering time off to all store employees, primarily younger staff, affected by the tragedy.

Jo Natale, Wegmans Food Markets Inc. spokeswoman, said Friday that the store, at 6600 Pittsford Palmyra Road, is able to adjust schedules and cover any absences that may result.

The Perinton store employs 600 full- and part-time workers.

"We have returning college students," she said. "We have other part-time employees who are willing to work additional hours. Everyone is helping out."

Natale said employees could take off a couple of days or a couple of weeks. "It varies by each individual and their own personal needs."
