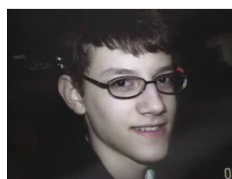

Remembering Matthew, teens & deadly driving



Young drivers make up nearly a quarter of the victims in deadly crashes in the state. Over the past year, Rochester has lost dozens of teenagers. Now one family from Henrietta is trying to make a difference.

"It's always something that's right in the back of our minds. It never goes away, ever." Bernadette and Paul Kato think of their son Matthew every single day. Paul says, "There's no fairness or justice. We miss Matthew terribly."

Their 17-year-old son was hit and killed by a drunk driver in July of 2004. His life and death are depicted in an exhibit unveiled today at the Monroe County Office Building.

Bernadette said, "There were a lot of memories for me, good ones and bad ones."

There were photos of their son with his cat Tiger and pictures with his best friend Shawn Elliot who was in the car the night he died. The most shocking of all in the exhibit - his autopsy photo.

Matthew's father said, "Just seeing your son totally naked on a table being examined, it's just a very, very graphic horrific image."

His mother insisted it be added to the exhibit. "I had insisted that they put that in there. I wanted people to be able to see the stark reality."

The exhibit goes into details, some never seen before. A document from Strong Hospital shows Matthew had a broken neck, collapsed lung, crushed liver, crushed spleen and brain damage.

Bernadette says, "It was actually shocking to me to see how much damage was done to his body by that crash."

Kristian Kemp killed Matthew Kato. He was driving drunk that night and was going more than 90 miles per hour.

The exhibit shows one of his prior DWI convictions. Paul said, "It brought up a lot of the anger from four and a half years ago, almost like it was yesterday."

Even through their pain and anger, the Kato's want to make a difference. Bernadette said, "I'm hoping that people really do pay attention to the message which is don't drink and drive."

Matthew Kato's story is just part of the exhibit. It includes other stories of teens that have died in drunk driving accidents. One story is that of a prom queen from Steuben County.

The exhibit is called "One Second, Everything Changes." It will be on display through Friday at the Monroe County Office Building and after that it will move to local schools and libraries.



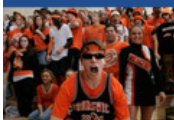
