

Athletes Suspended for Drinking

The Honeoye Falls-Lima Central School District is disciplining student athletes for their involvement in drinking.

School administrators received a call on Monday regarding an unsupervised party where alcohol was present. The district investigated the September 17th incident and found that some athletes were involved.

By violating the training rule, students will miss 25 percent of the remaining sports season and will be referred for counseling.

"The school district will continue to investigate incidents of training rules violations. I would encourage anyone with knowledge of training rule violations or dangerous student behavior to contact school officials so that we can follow up to ensure student safety," said Honeoye Falls-Lima athletic director Brian Donohue.

A similar incident happened at Penfield High School. District authorities suspended athletes for attending a party where alcohol was served.
