Man charged with DWI has 21 suspensions

A Henrietta man last night was taken into custody for allegedly driving while intoxicated and driving with a suspended license, according to Ontario County Sheriff's deputies.

Brandon Beaman, 25, of 4 Lalanne Road, was charged last night with driving while intoxicated, first-degree unlicensed operation of a motor vehicle and was ticketed for speeding, deputies said.

He was stopped at 9:45 p.m. while traveling north on Route 65 in West Bloomfield. He was allegedly traveling 30 mph over the 40 mph speed limit, deputies said.

Beaman also allegedly told officers that he'd been drinking and failed several field sobriety tests, deputies said.

Deputies said Beaman's license has been suspended 21 times. He reportedly failed to answer a summons on 10 different dates.

He was arraigned yesterday in West Bloomfield Town Court and remanded to the Ontario County Jail in lieu of \$10,000 cash bail or \$20,000 bond, deputies said. He is slated to return to court at a later to date to answer the charges.
